

Manually self-assembling the lift



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Practical guidelines when setting up

- Always use gloves when setting up.
- Climbing the ladder and standing on the furniture platform is prohibited.
- During installation, always keep the cable taut so that the safety retains contact with the motor.
- Always connect the plugs of both the remote control and automatic stop.
- The maximum platform weight is 200 kg per lifting operation.
- Only use the lift on a stable surface.
- Always raise the lift by the ladder and never by the carriage.

Wind the spool properly

Make sure the **spool is always taut during winding.** Make sure the coil does not get caught between the spool and side plate. Incorrect winding causes a lot of damage to the lift.





Rules of thumb

- The wheels must not touch the ground when using the lift
- Place the ladder at a maximum of 3 metres distance from the wall at an angle of approx. 70°
- Always secure the ladder at the top and brace it with a pipe for support

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Setting up the ladder lift

• Secure the auto-stop contact just above or below the top step of the ladder with a clamp. Only hand tighten and secure it on the **right-hand side** (when standing in front of the ladder).

2 Raise the ladder with head section (cable wheel) and install the auto-stop using the provided rope.

3 4 Add ladders from the bottom to obtain the desired height. Add the motor last.

S Fasten the ladders together using the provided bolts. Always place the eye of the bolts on the outside (only hand tighten). Secure the ladder at the top with a tension strap (e.g. to a radiator or balcony). This is to prevent the lift from tipping over.

6 Make sure you connect the electric plugs of the power supply, remote control, and emergency stop.

Use the remote control to activate the cable (with hook) and allow it to run anticlockwise around the wheel on the top ladder back to the carriage. **IMPORTANT:** Always keep the cable taut during installation AND attach the cable to the carriage **under** the curved bar. The cables must not cross each other and must run parallel to each other.

10 11 Secure the furniture platform/box on the carriage and make sure it is level. Secure all platform pins with cotter pins.

If needed, attach side guards to the furniture platform/box.

¹³ You must install a pipe for support when you will use the ladder lift for a second or third floor, or when lifting more than 100 kg. It is best to place it just above the middle of the ladder.

Use the remote control to operate the furniture platform/box.

Dismantling the ladder lift

- Always use work gloves when dismantling.
 - Take the furniture platform/box off the carriage.
- Disconnect the cable from the carriage and rewind it using the remote control.
- Always keep the cable slightly taut while continuing to guide the cable.
- Attach the hook of the cable to the spring on the motor. Do not tighten it.
- Disconnect electrical wires.
- Dismantle and remove each of the ladder pieces starting at the bottom.

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
